## The Do's

- 1. Plenty of research about classic motorcycles

- 5. Phone businesses, friends or clubs for advice if you are unsure
- 6. View every prospect with a critical eye

## **The Don'ts**

- 1. Buy any restoration project JUST because it is cheap
- 2. Purchase anything you haven't done any research on
- 3. Purchase a "basket case", other than for spares, unless you know what you are doing and have the knowledge to be able to complete it
- 4. Under estimate your total budget
- 5. Wear "rose" tinted glasses when going to view a prospective motorcycle
- 6. Purchase any "rare" motorcycles as spares may be difficult to locate
- 7. Purchase anything that does run, or have a good supply of spares unless you have knowledge or help for you to complete your restoration. Phone or talk to the various clubs and businesses for advice.
